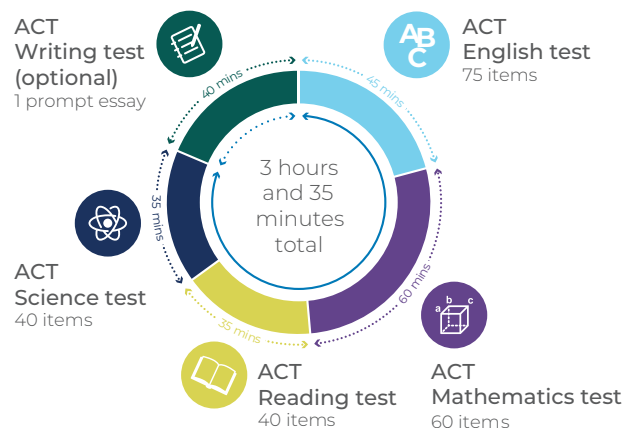
- ACT (no writing) will be \$150 (USD)
- ACT with writing will be \$166.50 (USD)

THE ACT® TEST IS:

- The university admissions test taken most by the high school graduating class in the United States in the past 5 years.
- Accepted for admissions by all four-year universities in the United States, and more than 225 universities around the world.
- Offered at test centers in 140 countries.

TEST CONTENT

The ACT consists of multiple-choice questions in English, math, reading, and science. The ACT test takes approximately 3 hours and 35 minutes to complete, including a short break. The ACT offers an optional 40-minute writing test that most international students select.



WHY TAKE THE ACT

- The ACT is reliable and consistent. Students and universities have relied on ACT scores for more than 60 years to determine how well prepared students are for university courses.
- The ACT is the only university admissions test that offers a science section and score.
- The ACT provides a STEM score to indicate readiness for university courses in science, technology, engineering, and math.
- The ACT Score Report provides recommendations for university majors that fit your interests, abilities, and values.
